We cover a broad scale of topics according to what our target group find interesting (e.g. youth participation, intercultural dialogue, active citizenship, entrepreneurship, sport, healthy lifestyle, peace-building, but also art and culture). All of our projects and activities are based on the approaches of non-formal education, experiential and intercultural learning, social inclusion and active participation. Our team consists of several youth workers and youth leaders of various profiles. The management of our NGO has over 10 years of experience in the NGO sector. We are experienced in preparing/organizing and training in different kind of projects and events.

What are the activities and experience of the organisation in the areas relevant for this application?

Here are some examples of some long-term projects that we worked on:

Eco-Friendly Sports – aim of the project is promote sport and physical activities that not only contribute to better health, but has also positive impact on environment, develop new methods of environmental education through sport and to increase amount of organized events like clean-up events, plogging, planting trees, birdhouse building, repair cafés etc. on local level,

CUstomized SuPport to Youth Development of Active Leadership - project in cooperation between Europe and Latin America fostering empowerment, leadership skills and social entrepreneurship of disadvantaged young people through various trainings, youth exchange, competitions, local conferences.



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Entrepreneurship Skills for Youth – aim of the project is to encourage and assist young people to become (socially responsible) entrepreneurs through local workshops and trainings.

IMAPPY – A Strengthened Network and An Integration Map for Refugees – we developed an application and "survival kit" for migrants with all needed information, contacts, institutions for their integration in Slovak society.

Building Democratic Europe Together – aim of the project was to raise awareness about totalitarian regimes and promote value of democracy among young people through creation of video interviews with civil society activists who were involved in the transition process and fight against communism in Slovakia.

You are Welcome – aim of the project was to support integration of foreigners in Slovakia and overcome stereotypes, prejudices or intolerance of Slovak people through various events or workshops.

Winter Sport is Coming - aim to promote winter sports not only as physical activity, but also as educational tool to support social inclusion and intercultural dialogue among young people from different backgrounds by development and implementation of Winter Sports Camps.

Lenka Curillova is the founder and executive director of the organization. Before the establishment of ADEL, she worked in several NGOs and institutions, participated in many various trainings, youth exchanges, conferences, and also did an EVS in Macedonia. She holds PhD in EU Studies from Comenius University and she was also teaching courses and did research on European youth policy. She was also chosen to represent Slovakia as an OSCE Youth Ambassador, as fellow of program in U.S. "Sustaining Civic Participation in Minority Communities" or in program about business growth of developing countries in International

Management Institute in India. She has a lot of experience in the field of project and financial management gained through preparation and implementation of projects (Erasmus+, Europe for Citizens, Interreg, Visegrad Fund, national grants etc.).

Jana Turanská is Project Coordinator in ADEL Slovakia and also pursuing a Ph.D. in history at Palacký University in Olomouc. Jana specializes in historical research related to religion, minorities, and marginalized social groups, especially Jews.
