of Active Leadership is a project based on cooperation between Europe (Slovakia, Italy, North Macedonia) and Latin America (Brazil, Costa Rica, Uruguay). Project is financed by the European Union, Erasmus+ Programme (Key Action 2, Capacity Building in the field of youth). There are various educational and research activities planned in the next

months, this training is one of them.

Project Objectives: CUSPYDAL aims to enhance social inclusion of disadvantaged

young people (affected by unemployment, from rural or less developed areas); to contribute to their personal and professional development, enhance their soft and life skills, employability and entrepreneurship and to support their

active participation in the local communities.

Training Course: "Learning to Empower" is training course for youth workers

that will be held in Sassari, Italy from 24 - 31 July, 2019.

Objectives of the training course are:

- to foster youth workers competences in the development of

the leadership potential of disadvantaged youth,

- to provide them with knowledge, skills, non-formal education methods how to promote social inclusion, and

stimulate entrepreneurship and active citizenship of NEET in

their communities,

- to test of non-formal educational models produced in the

research results,

- to produce workshops and tools of NFE that will be tested

during next youth exchange for young people from

disadvantaged background.

















Language: The official language of the training will be English.

Profile of participants: Training is intended for youth workers, volunteers or active

members in NGOs (preferably those who work or volunteer with

youngsters from disadvantaged background).

There will be 24 participants, 4 from each country.

Participants should be over 18 years old/no upper age limit

and be able to understand and communicate in English

(although no professional level required).

VENUE

Sassari, Italy





Sassari is the biggest and most important city in North Sardinia due to the economic and cultural activities carried out in loco. It is rich of museums, monuments, and cultural attractions and traditional events such as the *Cavalcata Sarda* in May and the *Discesa dei Candelieri*

It is about 40 km away from Alghero, a small and coastal city. Several beautiful beaches are situated in here.

















COSTS and RESPONSIBILITIES

Accommodation and food during the training will be arranged and fully covered thanks to the financial support of Erasmus + grant.

Project coordinator (organization ADEL Slovakia) will buy flight tickets for all participants. Flight tickets will be selected and discussed with partner organization from each country, keeping on mind requirement to find the most cost-effective way of transportation.

Local transport tickets (either in home country or in Italy) will be paid by participants themselves and reimbursed after the training course. They will have to keep all travel tickets, or boarding-passes (without these documents, we will not be able to reimburse local transport costs). Participants will give all tickets from home country to Italy to coordinator during the training; return boarding passes and travel tickets should be given to the sending organization from respective country after arrival back to the country. Detailed instructions will be provided during the training.

Participants can arrive max. 2 days before the start date of training and leave max. 2 days after the end date of the training. Please take into consideration, that costs related to board and lodging during those days must be financed through own costs of participants.

Its obligatory for all selected participants **to attend whole training.** After selection of the participants, they will be obliged to sign document provided by project coordinator and commit, that they will participate actively during the training.

















ARRIVAL: HOW TO REACH SASSARI?

Alghero and Olbia have airports which connect North Sardinia with many destinations in Italy and Europe.

HOW TO REACH SASSARI FROM ALGHERO AIRPORT?

From the airport you can take the big blue-red bus Arst (the busstop it's just on the right side of the main EXIT) and get off in the bus station of Sassari.


It is located in Corso Vittorio Emanuele II, a few minutes walking from Piazza d'Italia, and from Sassari's main attractions.








TRAINING ROOM
